- Manage evidence, documentation, and hearings in strict alignment with ELRC jurisprudence.
- Execute lawful termination procedures across both disciplinary and non disciplinary scenarios.
- Manage poor performance cases using structured, legally compliant Performance Improvement Plans (PIPs).
- Navigate industrial relations, union engagement, and collective bargaining frameworks effectively.
- Apply ILO conventions and international labour standards to local workplace policies.
- Strengthen organizational compliance and develop a proactive employee relations strategy.
